All students are required to read **two books** and complete an activity for each book. They are required to save all their work on Office 365, via One Drive. As the school year starts, the Language Arts Teacher will provide information on how to submit the work through Teams.

- You will select **two** eBooks from an array of genres through our different free platforms. Different types of literature (*biographies, fiction, nonfiction*); different formats (*graphic novels, traditional print*); different genres (historical fiction, poetry, mystery, science fiction);
- Make sure **the book you select is on your grade level.**
